

I got a copy of this book to review through the Vine program. This is the first book in a new childrenâ™s beginning chapter book series. Me and my seven year old son both read this book

separately, so I included both of our perspectives in the below review. Eight year old Drake lives on a farm but gets taken away from his home to a castle where he finds out he has been chosen to train as a dragon master. Drake's dragon ends up being a rather pitiful Earth Dragon. Of course as things progress you find out that the dragons aren't necessarily at the castle by their own will. You also find out that the Earth Dragon is not as weak as he first seems. This is a well done fantasy book with some nice little life lessons. This is just the start and introduction to this world. The story will appeal to younger children, probably in the 1st to 3rd grade age range. It's a great book for children who are ready to move on to chapter books, but not quite ready for middle grade level reads. As far as reading difficulty this book is very similar to the Secrets of Droon series by Tony Abbott. So it's a bit easier than the Magic Treehouse books. The easier reading level means sentences are shorter and characters sound a bit choppy when they talk (just because words of lower reading level are used). The storyline is very simple and easy to follow. There is some magic and wonder as Drake discovers that he is supposed to bond with and train with a Dragon. Although there is an immediate problem that is solved in this book, it looks like this is just part of a much larger story. My seven year old had the following to say about the book. He really liked it and enjoyed reading about a character close to his age.
