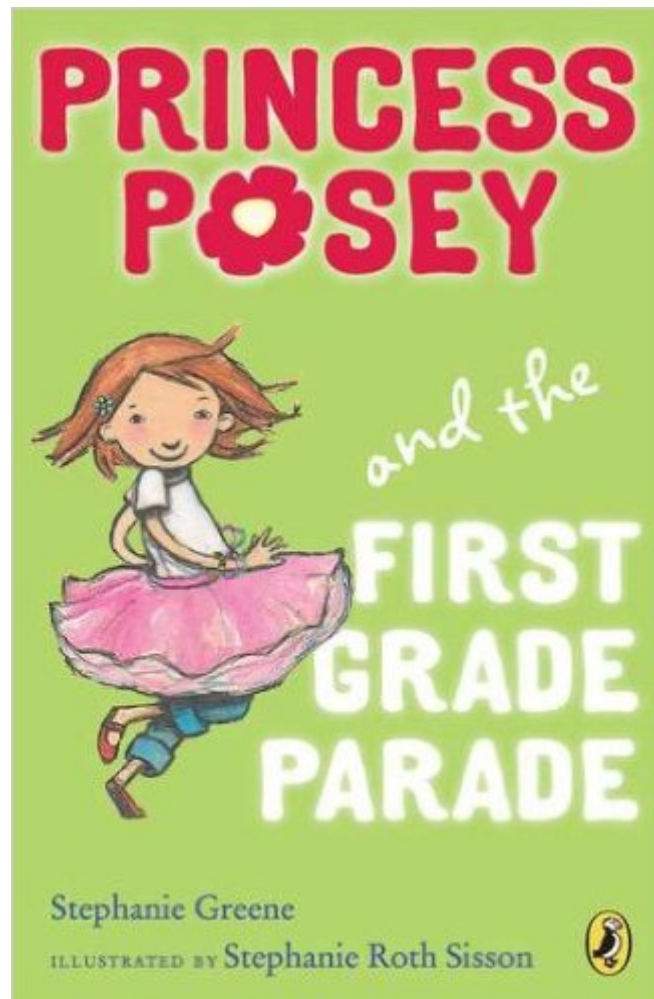

It doesn't help that her neighbors, Nick and Tyler, try and scare her about the big, blue hallway she will have to navigate

alone. To add insult to injury, Posey won't be able to wear her beloved, albeit ratty, pink tutu that she wears every single day. Her tutu gives her magical strength and Posey knows for certain it would give her the courage to face first grade. On a trip to town with Grandpa, Posey spies her new teacher, Miss Lee. Miss Lee notices Posey's tutu and comments on it, likening it to her own ratty pink sneakers that she loves to wear. When Posey suggests they wear them to school anyway, Miss Lee looks thoughtful.
