This collection continues IDW's reprints of the original TMNT comics. I love the size of the book as it really allows you to appreciate the art more. The annotations and commentary are excellent and build interest in the stories. As for the stories themselves, they are fun stories and dark at times. I especially like how the stories slowly build up without the reader realizing it until the end. Very much worth getting and makes you want to read the rest of the stories a whole lot more. Luckily Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles: The Ultimate Collection Volume 3 is already out and 4 and 5 are coming soon.

This is the second volume of the turtles collection that containsthe beginning of the story of the return of an iconic enemy whenLeonardo gets his shell kicked by the Foot and a resurrected Shredder.The turtles, April, and Casey Jones are forced to flee April's burningapartment (and the city in general) to Casey's grandmother's cottagein Massachusetts. (this is where the '91 movie got most of its plot,including the narration of the turtle's conditions by April)This volume also contains the rest of the one-issue micro series(Raphael's micro series issues was contained in the first

volume) along with an interesting (but very weird) story on time-travel and dimension hopping. An AWESOME read, and a must-have for a fan of any of the incarnations of the TMNT.

Are you or someone you love addicted to mutant reptiles? Do you enjoy stunning martial-arts action in a half-shell? Are you interested in the work of folks like Jack Kirby and Frank Miller, but already read all their stuff? No matter the reason, these hardcover volumes of the greatest sensation to come out of the 80s deserve a place in your home. Beautiful over-sized tomes presented in the original black and white at a price you can afford, complete with notes from both Eastman AND Laird! It is easy to see why the TMNT have endured for so many years. If you're new to the franchise, perhaps through the excellent Nickelodeon show, or even the newer comics by IDW, then do yourself a favor and pick this classic up. Grab the whole set. It's well worth the price. This is missing three issues. IDW decided that due to the stories not being done mainly by Eastman and Laird, that it's ok to leave them out. IDW needs to understand that when you call it an ultimate edition, it means every story. Not just major story lines. But, this is ok if all you want are major story lines. So, it's the purchaser's choice.

What I like about these books is that they are several of the books compiled into one, they're hard cover and they are still in black and white. I still have the original Mirage (the original original)

comics, so I'm comparing these to those. However, I am mostly interested in just the stories, and not the collectibility of each book, so I'm wanting to consolidate the stories into one book. These books are perfect for that, and what's more, it's like they come with a director's commentary, having both Eastman's and Laird's comments for each page.
