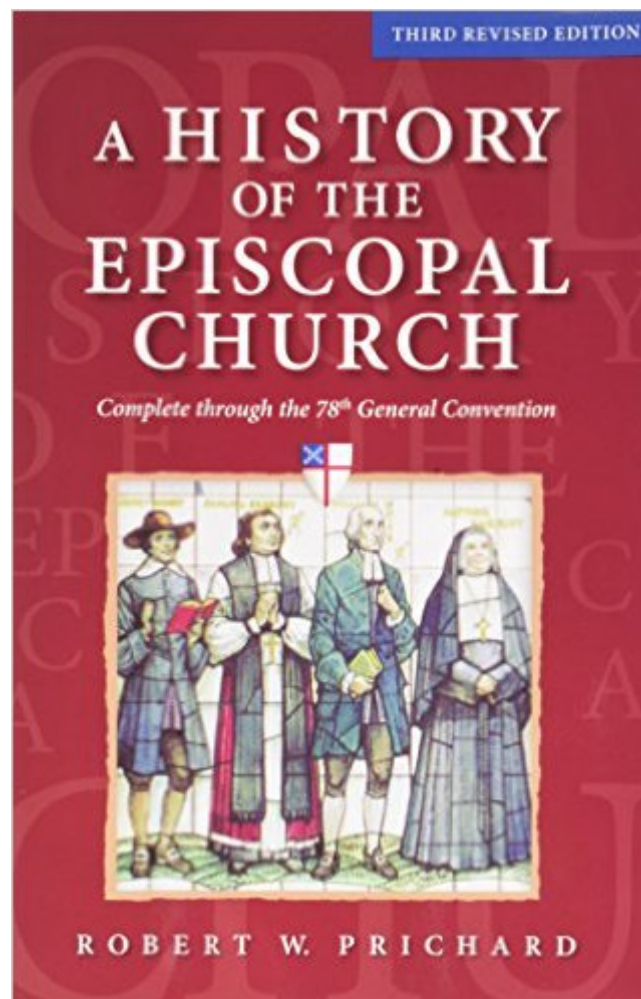


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A History Of The Episcopal Church - Third Revised Edition: Complete Through The 78th General Convention

However it is well researched and written and gives some perspectives and explanations of our roots that I hadn't thought about. It is particularly good in interpreting the events that created the American Episcopal Church as it exists today.

Probably the best book available on the history of The Episcopal Church. I used this a course in Anglican history. I wish I had bought the paperback. The Kindle Version does not have page numbers so is next to useless for citations.

Dr. Prichard has done it again. He has written the most up-to-date history of the Episcopal Church. He made some minor changes to the information from his previous histories and then added new details about the recent changes in the Church.
