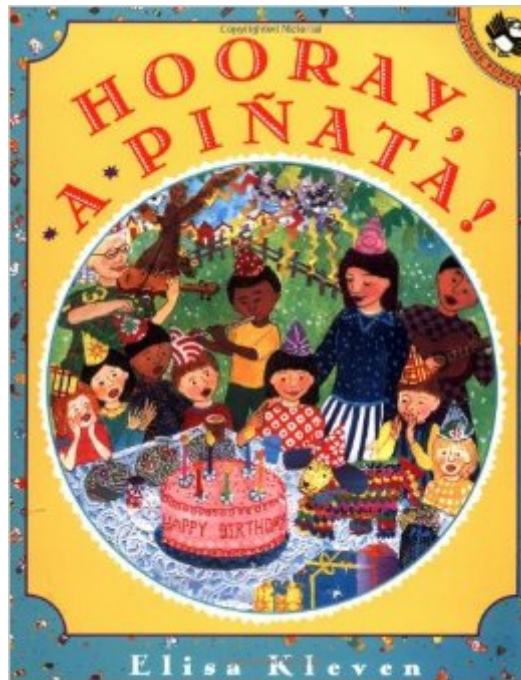

My 4-year-old daughter and I both loved this story. The illustrations are colorful and lively and the dialogue is easy for a young child to follow. Hooray A Pinata is a great book to read when you're planning a child's birthday party. The story is about a little girl who chooses a little dog pinata to be used as a game for her birthday party. She ends up becoming friends with it and decides that she doesn't want to stuff it with candy and break it open. Her friend is disappointed because he loves playing pinata so he buys her a new huge pinata that they can use instead. A note of interest: the book explains that pinatas originated in Italy. I didn't know that!

This was a great book to introduce the idea of a Spanish based culture and other traditions that others practice, and the kids really liked this book and we made our own piñata with healthy treats inside and they loved that!
